What I need to do:

Decide what kind of a learner you are and what kind of activity excites you most!

Create a 3D model of a Viking ship;

or

Write your own account of a Viking invasion.

If you are creating a 3D model of a Viking ship, think about:

1. the types of ships that were used by the Vikings;
2. the key features of a Viking ship.

The model must include a written explanation of how you made it or why you chose to make that model.

If you are writing your own account of a Viking invasion, think about:

1. the setting (where the invasion took place);
2. the main events that occurred;
3. the battle weapons used.

You may wish to include a map, pictures or photographs.

What I am learning & why?

This half term we are learning about the Vikings. We are learning about myths from the Viking era; how and where people lived; why the Vikings invaded; and their influence on the UK locally and globally.

In Science, we are studying properties of materials. This includes reversible and irreversible changes.

Resources I will need:

- Paper / card
- Shoe box
- Glue or sellotape
- Paint/ felt tips/colouring pencils for decoration
- Internet and books (research)
- Writing paper
- Dictionary/ thesaurus

Questions to think about:

1. Who were the Vikings?
2. How did the Vikings fight?
3. Where did the Vikings invade?
4. What were they key events during the important battles?
