## What I am learning & why?

This half term, Year 3 students are investigating Ancient Egypt. In History and Literacy, children will be investigating how Ancient Egyptian life has affected us, such as in farming and construction. As part of the topic we would like the children to learn about and develop a rich understanding of Ancient Egyptians.

## What I am learning & why?

The Ancient Egyptian civilisation is fascinating and mysterious to us as they left so much behind that we are still finding out about.

There are two parts:

1. Design and create a 2D or 3D mask of an Ancient Egyptian God, pharaoh or sphinx.  
Your mask will need to include:
  - card
  - crayons
  - paint
  - glue
2. Children must write at least one paragraph about who their mask is of and why they were important in Egyptian times. Can you include any other information about the wearer of the mask?

What are some of the important things about Ancient Egypt?

Who was important in Ancient Egyptian times?

How will I make my mask eye-catching (attract an audience)?

How am I going to transfer this information into my own words?
